Please ask your US Senators and your US Representative to oppose any attempts in this new Congress and by the White House to waive environmental and other laws - whether for the Purple Line or any other projects and programs. You can use the following sample as the basis for your call, fax, or email:

Sample script:

Hi, my name is ____, and I'm from [City, State]. I'm calling to ask you oppose any attempts in this new Congress and by the White House to waive the environmental and other laws of this nation, whether for infrastructure projects like Maryland's Purple Line whose environmental impact statement has been found in violation of the law by a federal court, or for any other projects and programs.

Our laws protect citizens, public health, endangered species and the environment at large. They help separate the wheat from the chaff. Please confirm to me that you will oppose any attempt to waive the law for the Purple Line or any other project.
